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**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY EXEMPTION FOR THE USE OF REFLEX 2LC TO
CONTROL BROADLEAF WEEDS IN SNAP BEANS
April 14, 2004**

The Environmental Protection Agency has granted a specific exemption under the provisions of Section 18 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to the Arkansas State Plant Board for the use of Reflex 2LC Herbicide (fomesafen, EPA Reg. No. 10182-83 or 100-993) for the control of broadleaf weeds in snap beans. **Applicators must be in possession of the Reflex 2LC Herbicide Emergency Exemption Labeling at the time of application.** All applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA product label for Reflex 2LC and this notice must be followed.

Application of Reflex 2LC may be made at a rate of 0.75 to 1 pint of product (0.188 to 0.25 lb. active ingredient) per acre. Total use of Reflex 2LC may not exceed 1.5 pints product (0.375 lb. active ingredient) per acre per year. Application may be made via ground or air.

A 30 day pre-harvest interval must be observed.

A maximum of 2,000 acres of snap beans may be treated under this exemption.

For use in the Arkansas Counties of Benton, Crawford, Lonoke, and Pulaski only.

This product is toxic to birds and mammals. Drift and run-off may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Reflex 2LC may not be applied to sites where run-off is likely to occur to aquatic habitats. In areas where soils are permeable and the water table is shallow fomesafen may leach into groundwater. Do not graze livestock in treated fields. Care should be taken to avoid adverse impact to endangered or threatened species that may occur in treatment areas.

To help mitigate concerns for risk to wildlife from exposure of fomesafen, the lowest rate possible should be used that will still provide adequate control.

A report of each application made under the Exemption must be filed with the Plant Board within 10 days. The following format is suggested for use by the applicator so the information required by the EPA will be provided: **THIS INFORMATION IS NOT TO BE REPORTED ON PINK FORM NUMBER 1007.**
