

**NOTICE OF EMERGENCY EXEMPTION FOR THE USE OF INTREPID 2F TO CONTROL SALTMARSH CATERPILLAR AND ARMYWORM IN SOYBEANS**  
**September 17, 2004**

The Environmental Protection Agency has granted a specific exemption under the provisions of Section 18 of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to the Arkansas State Plant Board for the use of Intrepid 2F Insecticide (methoxyfenozide, EPA Reg. No.62719-442 and 707-277)for the control of Saltmarsh Caterpillar and Armyworm in soybeans. **Applicators must be in possession of the Intrepid 2F Insecticide Emergency Exemption Labeling at the time of application.** All applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the EPA product label for Intrepid 2F (EPA Reg. No.62719-442 and 707-277)and this notice must be followed.

Intrepid 2F may be applied by ground or air at a rate of 0.06 to 0.125 lbs. a.i. (4.0 to 8.0 ounces product) per acre. Do not apply more than 16.0 oz. (0.25 lb. a.i.)of product per acre per year. Applications may be made by conventional ground equipment or by air. Application through any type of irrigation system is prohibited.

No more than 2 applications may be made per season. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

A 7-day plant-back interval is required for residues of methoxyfenozide.

**Each application made under this Emergency Exemption must be reported to the Plant Board within 10 days.**

### ATTENTION

- **Section 18 Specific Exemption:** This use is authorized under EPA specific exemption pursuant to Section 18 of the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended.
- **This specific exemption is effective May 18, 2004 and expires October 30, 2004.**
- It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
- This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.
- Read the label affixed to the container for Intrepid\* 2F insecticide before applying. Carefully follow all precautionary statements and applicable use directions.
- Use of Intrepid 2F according to this supplemental labeling is subject to all use precautions and limitations imposed by the label affixed to the product container for Intrepid 2F.
- All applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions on the registered product label for Intrepid 2F (Dow AgroSciences EPA Reg. No. 62719-442, Rohm and Haas EPA Reg. No. 707-277) are to be followed.

### Directions for Use

**Ground Application:** Apply Intrepid 2F in a minimum spray volume of 10 gallons per acre by conventional ground equipment.

**Aerial Application:** Apply in a minimum spray volume of 5 gallons per acre in equipment that has been properly patterned and calibrated for environmental conditions at the site.

**Spray Adjuvants:** Select adjuvants that are recommended and registered for your specific use pattern and follow their use directions. Always add adjuvants last in the mixing process.
